

Tulle Obsessed Over-skirt

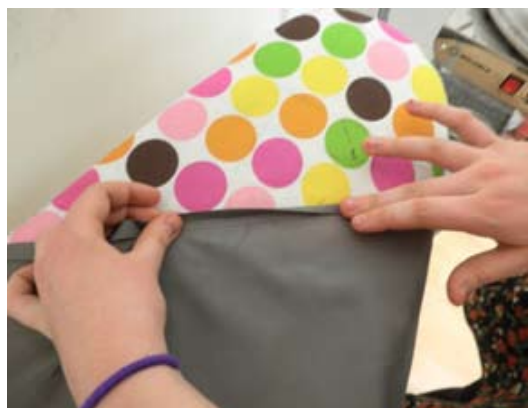
For this holiday, forget the little black dress. Take your look up a notch with this cool overskirt. Wear it over a body suit or a mini dress, funk it up with multiple strands of pearl necklaces. Be the belle of the ball!



Materials needed
2M of black tulle (either 45" or 60" wide).
2M of lining.
3M of Grosgrain ribbon.



Step 1: Keep the lining folded in half. Cut along the folded edge. You will only need one of the two pieces.



Step 2: Finish three edges of the lining with a narrow hem.

To do so: Fold the edge toward the wrong side of the fabric $\frac{1}{4}$ " twice. Stitch along the inner folded edge.

Note: Do not finish the waist edge.



Step 3: Attach the tulle to the skirt lining at Waist. Lay the tulle on top of the right side of the fabric. Pin, stitch with a large basting stitch (basically a gathering stitch) along the waist.



Step 4: Waist band - in the middle of the ribbon, mark your waist measurement on the ribbon. You should have extra length on each end of the ribbon for the bow.



Step 5: Pull the gathering stitch to create gathering. Adjust the gathering until it is the same measurement as your waist measurement.



Step 6: Pin the gathered skirt waist to the ribbon between your markings. Stitch close to the ribbon edge that is pinned to the skirt.



You are done!
